17.05 EQUIPMENT

The City of Blair shall be responsible for providing its share of the equipment for the Fire Department. It is understood that the Town of Preston and the Department itself will assist in providing the necessary fire fighting equipment.

17.06 POLICE POWERS

- (1) The Fire Chief is hereby vested with full and complete police authority at the scene of a fire. The Chief may prescribe limits in the vicinity of any fire restricting the public from access or entry thereto. He shall have the power to authorize the removal or destruction of any property necessary to prevent the further spread of a fire.
- (2) It shall be lawful for any member of the Fire Department, while acting under the direction of the Chief, to enter any adjacent premises for the purpose of fighting and or containing a fire.

17.07 FIRE PREVENTION CODE

- (1) It shall be the policy of the City of Blair to ensure public safety by regular inspections of public buildings and to ensure compliance with state and local fire safety codes.
- (2) Sections 101.14(2)(b) WI. STAT. is incorporated by reference with respect to regular periodic inspections of public buildings.
- (3) Section 101.14(1)(bm) WI. STAT. is incorporated by reference with respect to inspections of private dwellings if requested by property owners.
- (4) Orders to rectify and repair
 - (A) The Chief or his Deputy, has the authority to issue orders to rectify and repair hazardous and unsafe conditions.
 - (B) The property owner has 15 days to comply with the Order.
 - (C) Failure to complete the Repair Order will be deemed a violation of this Fire Prevention Code. Any person violating this code shall forfeit not less than \$50.00 or more than \$250.00 for each violation.

17.08 FIRE PREVENTION

The Wisconsin Administrative Code, Chapter SPS 314, entitled Fire Prevention, and any amendments thereto, is adopted by reference.

17.09 FIRE DEPARTMENT SAFETY AND HEALTH STANDARDS

The Wisconsin Administrative Code, Chapter SPS 330, entitled Fire Department Safety and Health Standards, and any amendments thereto, is adopted by reference.
