20.01 STATEMENT OF INTENT

- (1) Water pollution is a serious health hazard, which has potentially far reaching consequences. In addition to public health, there is a threat to fish and aquatic life, scenic and ecological balance. Pollution limits adequate domestic, municipal, recreational, industrial and other uses of water.
- (2) It shall be the policy of the City to combat water pollution to the best of its ability. This policy shall include, but not be limited to, full cooperation with the State of Wisconsin, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources and Trempealeau County.

20.02 ENFORCEMENT

- (1) The City has limited enforcement powers as it relates to water pollution. The principal responsibility of enforcement rests with the State, acting through the Department of Natural Resources, the Department of Justice and Trempealeau County, acting through its District Attorney.
- (2) Prosecution for violations of water pollution standards would include disorderly conduct as set forth in other provisions of these Ordinances.
