28.01 SNOW AND OTHER STREET HAZARD EMERGENCIES

- (1) Emergency. In the opinion of the street department superintendent, or in his absence the Chief of Police, whenever an emergency exists in the city (or in any section or sections thereof) because of snow, freezing rain, sleet, ice, snow drifts or other natural phenomena which create or will likely create hazardous road conditions impeding or likely to impede the free movement of fire, health, police, emergency or other vehicular traffic or otherwise endanger the safety or welfare of the community, such official may declare an emergency to exist for a period of seventy-two (72) hours or until the hazardous conditions causing the emergency have been removed as determined by such official.
- (2) Notice. Notice of such a declaration shall be made by placing or erecting temporary traffic signs at or reasonably near the corporate limits of the City on all state and county trunk highways and connecting highways informing motorists that 24-hour parking limitations, night parking regulations or snow emergency regulations are in effect in the municipality per Wis. Stat. 349.12(1e)(c)(2).
- (3) Parking Prohibited. No person shall park, or otherwise leave unattended, any vehicle on any street or in any area after the posting of the Notice required by (2) above.
- (4) Penalty. Any person violating provisions of this section shall be subjected to the penalty provisions as set forth in 28.03.

28.03 PENALTIES.

- 1) Violation of any provision of this Ordinance will result in a forfeiture of fifteen dollars (\$15.00). Failure to pay the forfeiture within five (5) working days will result in the forfeiture being increased to twenty-five dollars (\$25.00). If after thirty (30) calendar days the forfeiture remains unpaid, a forfeiture of fifty dollars (\$50.00) will be assessed.
- (2) Failure to pay the forfeiture as specified, subjects the person to a civil forfeiture of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) and prosecution as a traffic citation under Chapter 345, Wis. Stat.
