41.01		POLICY.

The intent of this ordinance is to prevent the consumption of alcoholic beverages upon and adjacent to public streets and public property in the City. The enforcement of this ordinance is intended to be uniformly applied; however, upon a finding of necessity, the Council may direct that enforcement be relaxed or suspended for a specified period of time.

41.02 RESTRICTIONS.

- (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to drink from, or have in his or her possession, an open container of fermented malt beverage or intoxicating liquor on any public street, sidewalk, alley or parking lot within the area bordered by West Center Street, Pearl Street, West First Street and State Highway 95 in the City of Blair.
- (2) It shall be unlawful to remove fermented malt beverages or intoxicating liquors, purchased by the glass or other open container, from the premises where purchased. Such purchases shall be consumed on the premises where served and shall not be removed therefrom.

41.03 PENALTIES

Any person violating this ordinance shall be subject to a forfeiture of not less than \$50.00, nor more than \$250.00, for each offence. Failure to pay the forfeiture, upon conviction, will result in the issuance of a Civil Commitment Order
