28.01 SNOW AND OTHER STREET HAZARD EMERGENCIES

- (1) Emergency. In the opinion of the street department superintendent, or in his absence the Chief of Police, whenever an emergency exists in the city (or in any section or sections thereof) because of snow, freezing rain, sleet, ice, snow drifts or other natural phenomena which create or will likely create hazardous road conditions impeding or likely to impede the free movement of fire, health, police, emergency or other vehicular traffic or otherwise endanger the safety or welfare of the community, such official may declare an emergency to exist for a period of seventy-two (72) hours or until the hazardous conditions causing the emergency have been removed as determined by such official.
- (2) Notice. Notice of such a declaration shall be made by posting in any area affected by the declared emergency, temporary “no parking” signs. The installation of such temporary signs during the existence of any declared emergency is pursuant to Section 66.325, Wis. Stat.
- (3) Parking Prohibited. No person shall park, or other wise leave unattended, any vehicle on any street or in any area marked by temporary “no parking” signs erected pursuant to this ordinance.
- (4) Penalty. Any person violating provisions of this section shall be subjected to the penalty provisions as set forth in 28.03.

28.02 ALTERNATE SIDE PARKING

- (1) During that portion of the year commencing with November 1st and continuing through March 31st of the succeeding year, a vehicle may be parked only on the even side of any street between twelve o’clock noon (12:00 P.M.) on any even numbered calendar date and twelve o’clock noon (12:00 P.M.) of the following day; and on the odd numbered side of any street between twelve o’clock noon (12:00 P.M.) on any odd numbered calendar date and twelve o’clock noon (12:00 P.M.) of the following day.
- (2) Where parking is normally permitted only on one side of the street, vehicles shall be parked on that side of the street only, notwithstanding subsection (1).

28.03 PENALTIES.

- 1) Violation of any provision of this Ordinance will result in a forfeiture of fifteen dollars (\$15.00). Failure to pay the forfeiture within five (5) working days will result in the forfeiture being increased to twenty-five dollars (\$25.00). If after thirty (30) calendar days the forfeiture remains unpaid, a forfeiture of fifty dollars (\$50.00) will be assessed.

- (2) Failure to pay the forfeiture as specified, subjects the person to a civil forfeiture of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) and prosecution as a traffic citation under Chapter 345, Wis. Stat.
