63.01 STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

As a matter of public health and safety, the ability to identify locations of residences, businesses and other structures is essential. Responding to fire, police and other emergencies is greatly enhanced by an identifiable numbering system in all zoning districts within the City. The City has assigned street numbers to each residence and business location within the City of Blair.

63.02 RESPONSIBILITY FOR INSTALLATION

It shall be the responsibility of each owner of property to display the assigned 911 number on each residence and business location.

- (A) The 911 number shall be 3 ½” high by 2 ¼” wide.
- (B) The 911 number shall be reflective.
- (C) The 911 number shall have a black number on a white background.
- (D) Duplexes shall have two (2) separate 911 numbers.
- (E) Mobile Homes shall each have their own 911 number.
- (F) The 911 number shall be affixed to the residence/building facing the street to which it is addressed to.
- (G) The 911 number shall be easily visible from the street it faces and free from obstructions of any kind.
- (H) For residences/buildings that also abut a public alley way, the street number shall be affixed to the residence/building that it may also be seen from the alley, in addition to the requirement of (F) above.
- (I) If the City provides such 911 numbers/plates to residents, it shall be done at cost (no upcharge).
- (J) New residences/buildings shall have the 911 number installed no later than the date of the issuance of the occupancy permit, or final inspection date, whichever occurs sooner.

The City shall cause the installation of the numbers at owner expense for those who fail to comply. Such installation shall be treated as a special assessment pursuant to Chapter 15 of the City Ordinances.
